Beginner Levels 1, 2, 3, and 4

Start learning French from the basics! Build your confidence step by step as you learn how to ask questions, use key verb tenses, and take part in simple conversations.

There are four progressive beginner levels, here is a glimpse of what you will learn:

Level Beginner 1

- The alphabet and numbers
- Greetings and introductions
- Pronunciation basics
- Present tense verb conjugations
- Essential vocabulary (e.g. body parts, everyday words)

Level Beginner 2

- Vocabulary about food, telling time, asking questions etc.
- Different types of accents and determiners
- Future tense verb conjugations
- How to take part in simple conversations
- Oral expression and pronunciation through regular practice

Level Beginner 3

- Vocabulary for planning activities
- Conversations about months, dates, seasons, and weather
- Verb conjugations in present, past, and future tenses
- Pronunciation of difficult sounds (e.g. ill, eil, ail)
- Oral expression and pronunciation through regular practice

Level Beginner 4

- Vocabulary about professions, daily habits, and clothing
- Conjugation of verbs ending in -dre, -te, -ir
- How to use the imperative and passé composé tenses
- Connector words to enrich your sentences
- Oral expression and pronunciation through regular practice

Intermediate Levels 1, 2, 3, 4

At the intermediate levels, you will expand your vocabulary, deepen your understanding of grammar, and improve your ability to communicate clearly in both spoken and written French.

There are four progressive beginner levels, here is a glimpse of what you will learn:

Level Intermediate 1

- Vocabulary related to health and everyday situations
- Expressions of frequency (never, always, sometimes, etc.)
- How to use the infinitive
- The imparfait tense
- The comparative form
- Oral expression and pronunciation through regular practice

Level Intermediate 2

- The passé composé, imparfait, and future tenses
- Conditional sentences and how to express possibilities
- Quantity adverbs
- Complement pronouns
- Oral expression and pronunciation through regular practice

Level Intermediate 3

- How to express time (since, now, in, for, etc.)
- Negative expressions and how to use them naturally
- Indirect pronouns and the conditionnel tense
- Conditional expressions using different tenses
- Oral expression and pronunciation through regular practice

Level Intermediate 4

- Verb tenses (passé composé, imparfait, futur simple, impératif présent, conditionnel présent)
- The subjonctif présent tense
- Conversations using direct and indirect pronouns, adverbs, and various determiners (demonstrative, possessive, indefinite)
- Oral expression and pronunciation through regular practice

Advanced

We offer six different advanced curricula. At the advanced level, you will enrich your vocabulary through a variety of engaging topics and become familiar with complex grammatical structures. Each curriculum is independent and non cumulative.

Conversation workshop
